

How do you pay?

- online or by phone using a Canadian financial institution's services.
- online at canada.ca/cra-my-payment.
- online by setting up a pre-authorized debit agreement at canada.ca/my-cra-account.

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 in person with your remittance voucher at your Canadian financial institution or, for a fee, at a Canada Post retail outlet (cash or debit only).

Note

There is now a QR code printed on your remittance voucher that contains all the information required to make your payment with cash or debit at a Canada Post retail outlet.

Personal information, including the social insurance number, is collected under the *Income Tax Act* to assess individual income tax for the federal government and the provinces and territories. It can be used for audit, compliance, or evaluation purposes and shared or verified with other federal and provincial/territorial government institutions.
